

Kim Yong-Ik's Solo Exhibition at Kukje Gallery, Seoul

Kukje Gallery, Seoul presents the solo exhibition of celebrated artist Kim Yong-Ik through December 30, 2016.

This is the first time that the gallery is exhibiting the artist's work, which consists of 30 new paintings created from 2015-16. Each work of art exhibited has one of the five titles: "Apocalypse of Modernism," "Thinner...and Thinner...," "After 20 Years," "Utopia" and "In the Lingering Shadow of Lies."

The recurring motif of polka dots first used by Kim in the early 1990s is present in this new collection also. This new collection is emblematic of the ongoing cultural evolution and presents a seminal chapter in Kim's artistic practice.

The exhibition is on view at 54 Samcheong-ro, Samcheong-dong, Jongno-gu, Seoul, South Korea.
