Art Basel Hong Kong just finished up over the weekend and we think we can now officially call it the region's biggest contemporary art gathering. Art Basel featured the work of hundreds of artists, displayed in 239 galleries across much of the city. Amazing. No wonder people are starting to call Art Basel, "Art Week" in old Honky.

This was the 4th time the event has been staged with over 60,000 visitors checking out the art over the weekend. There was a host of international artists at the event including Tatsuo Miyajim, Tracey Emin, Louise Bourgeois, Takashi Murakami, Marina Abramović and Juergen Teller, who's photograph of Kim Kardashian was on sale at the event for a cool, 1.27 billion VND. Some Vietnamese artists were also lucky enough to be part of the show for Basel HK 2016.
